

## **Roads and Footpaths**

**August 30<sup>th</sup> 2016**

### **Overgrown plants**

2 Millers Croft: Overgrown hedge

23 Low Green: Overgrown hedge

Low Green/Top Lane snicket: trees overgrown, fences bowed into snicket from pressure of bushes in the gardens.

Ryegate snicket: overgrown. Copmanthorpe Volunteers to tackle?

Hedge on junction of Hallcroft/College Road

### **Parking.**

Fairfax/Barons crescent: parking on corners, inhibiting sight lines

Temple Lane; parking on footpath

College Road, near junction with Hallcroft: often more than 5 cars in a row making the junction difficult to negotiate

The Link: parking very close to junction with Manor Heath

### **Potholes/road surface**

St Giles Way/Station Road junction

New Tadcaster Road, near bridge

Station Road/ Main Street junction: non-slip surface breaking up.

Manor Heath/ Hallcroft Lane Junction: non-slip surface breaking up.

Millers Croft/Sutor Close alleyway: footpath breaking up.

Horseman Drive: pothole outside no. 7

Church Street: outside Co-op. Whole of Church St needs resurfacing.

Sawyers Crescent: Pavement breaking up.

**Drains:**

Moor Lane: storm water drains outside Nos. 4 and 11 full and plants invading.

Church street: drain outside Co-op blocked.

Co-op still cluttering up pavement with trolleys, cages, containers, making it difficult for wheelchair users, people with prams/buggies to get by.

Royal Oak: frontage full of tables, benches, large plant containers, making it dangerous to pass as pedestrians have to go into the road on a busy corner in order to get by.
