Widely Recycled

Put straight into your home recycling boxes for kerbside collection.



Check Locally



Not Yet Recycled

Check if it is one of the items below. Some things labelled “not yet recycled” CAN be recycled, e.g. crisp packets.

Plastic bottles, trays, containers marked:



PETE HDPE

Food tins, drinks cans, aerosols.

Paper and cardboard.

Glass bottles and jars.

Plastic bags, bread bags, veg and fruit bags, bubble wrap.



LDPE

Aluminium foil and foil trays, aluminium drinks cans.

Crisps, nuts, popcorn, and pretzels packets (not ‘Cheddars’).

Sweet biscuit, cake bar and cracker wrappers (not flapjack, cereal, or chocolate bars).

Kenco/Tassimo/L’OR coffee refill packs, disks, pods and outer packaging.

Plastic pens, felt tips, marker pens, highlighters.

Toothpaste tubes, plastic toothbrushes and their outer packaging (not cardboard), electric toothbrush heads.

Pringles tubes including the foil seal and the lid (not other brands).

Drinks and food cartons, TetraPaks.

Plastic pots and tubs.
