

Food and Drinks Packaging - Where to Recycle in Copmanthorpe



Widely Recycled

Put straight into your home recycling boxes for kerbside collection.



Check Locally



Not Yet Recycled

Check if it is one of the items below. Some things labelled “not yet recycled” CAN be recycled, e.g. crisp packets.

Plastic bottles, yoghurt pots, trays, containers marked:



Food tins, drinks cans, aerosols, aluminium foil.

Paper and cardboard.

Glass bottles and jars.

Plastic bags, bread bags, veg and fruit bags, bubble wrap.



Drinks and food cartons, TetraPaks, Pringles tubes (except lids)

Aluminium drinks cans.

Crisps, nuts, popcorn, and pretzels packets (not ‘Cheddars’).

Sweet biscuit, cake bar and cracker wrappers (not flapjack, cereal, or chocolate bars).

Plastic pens, felt tips, marker pens, highlighters.

Flexible cheese packaging including nets & labels, plastic wrap from blocks and individual bars.

Flexible coffee packaging - bags for beans and ground coffee (not coffee pods).

Coffee pods from Nespresso, Tassimo, and Nescafé Dolce Gusto coffee machines

Home recycling boxes for kerbside collection

Tesco recycling point (in car park), **St. Andrews Church** car park, Bishopthorpe

Supermarket soft plastic recycling points (inside store)

Copmanthorpe Scouts, The Rec’ Centre car park
